Policy: Dress code

Remember you are a representative of Orthopedic Physical Therapy and our present patients. You should reflect a professional and business like appearance. All employees should come to work in appropriate clothing or may be sent home without pay.

Allowed clothing: Shorts can be worn, keeping in mind that **this professional office** and should be of appropriate, professional length.

Unallowable clothing:

Halter tops, low cut tops, sweat suits, blue jeans, pants that resemble blue jeans, mini skirts, athletic shorts, beachwear, and see-through shirts. Tongue piercing, Hats

Clothing should not display any words that contain

1. Race
2. Religion
3. Sexual preference or innuendos
4. Profanity
5. Political statements

Shirt length: Need to be long enough to be tucked into pants/skirt worn.

Skirt Length: NO higher than 6" above the knee

Shorts Length: NO higher than 6" above the knee

Under garments: Need to be concealed

Outside clinics: Employees operating in outside clinics must adhere to the dress code of that clinic
