Procedure: Iontophoresis

Iontophoresis is administered for the purpose of delivering soluble salts trans dermally for medical purposes.

O.P.T. uses the IontoPatch drug delivery system.

1. Patient is screened for contraindications to treatment and informed consent is obtained.
2. Physician order is obtained and the medication or solution being used for the treatment is called into the patient's pharmacy. The patient is responsible for picking up the prescription, paying applicable co-payment and bringing the solution into the PT clinic.
3. Patients with Medicare must sign an Advanced Beneficiary Notice, as that insurance does not provide coverage. The patient agrees to pay a charge of \$15.00 per IontoPatch.
4. The treatment area is cleaned in preparation for IontoPatch application. The solution is applied to the appropriate + (positive) or - (negative) electrode and then secured to the patient using the IontoPatch system (see enclosed technical overview).
5. The patient is instructed to wear the patch for 24 hours, keeping it clean and dry, if tolerated. If any adverse reactions occur, the patient is instructed to remove the patch immediately and report the reaction to their Physical Therapist.

Frequency and duration of the use of the IontoPatch is determined by physician's orders and the physical therapist's discretion.
